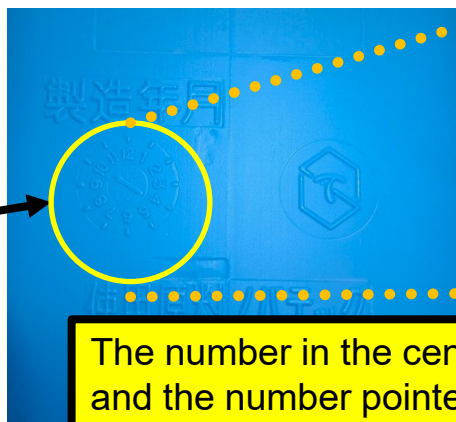
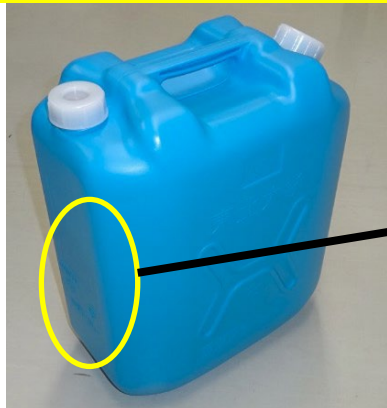


How to check the date of manufacture of the liquid waste tank

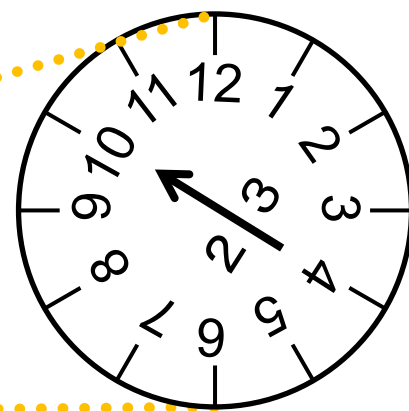
Please note that the display position is different for 18L and 10L.

Indication of the date of manufacture for **18L** liquid waste tanks

Year and month of manufacture Display position

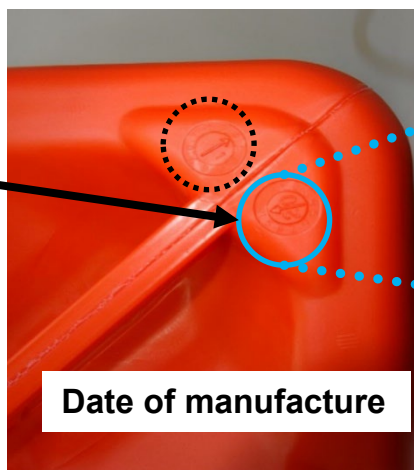


The number in the center indicates the year of manufacture and the number pointed by the arrow indicates the month of manufacture. Figure "Manufactured October 2023".



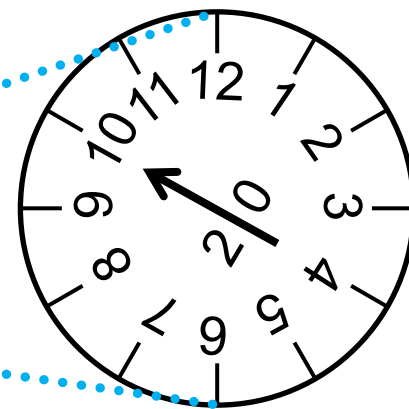
Indication of the date of manufacture for **10L** liquid waste tanks

Note on the date of manufacture of the liquid waste tank

- ① The Center's designated liquid waste tanks have a **useful life of "10 years"**.
- ② Check if the liquid waste tank in use is 10 years old by referring to "How to check the date of manufacture of the liquid waste tank".
- ③ **For safety reasons, liquid waste discharged from tanks that are over 10 years old will not be collected.**
 ※ Tanks that are over 10 years old are less durable and can be damaged by the slightest shock, resulting in the leakage of liquid waste.
- ④ Waste liquid tanks that fall under any of the following categories may not be used regardless of their service life.
 - The waste tank is cracked or damaged due to age-related deterioration.
 - The liquid waste tank is greatly inflated.
 - The waste liquid tank is not one of the tanks specified by the Center.
- ⑤ Disposal of liquid waste tanks is consigned to a disposal company about once a year, inquiries will be made in advance to the person in charge of each department, so please keep the tanks in your own hands until that time.
