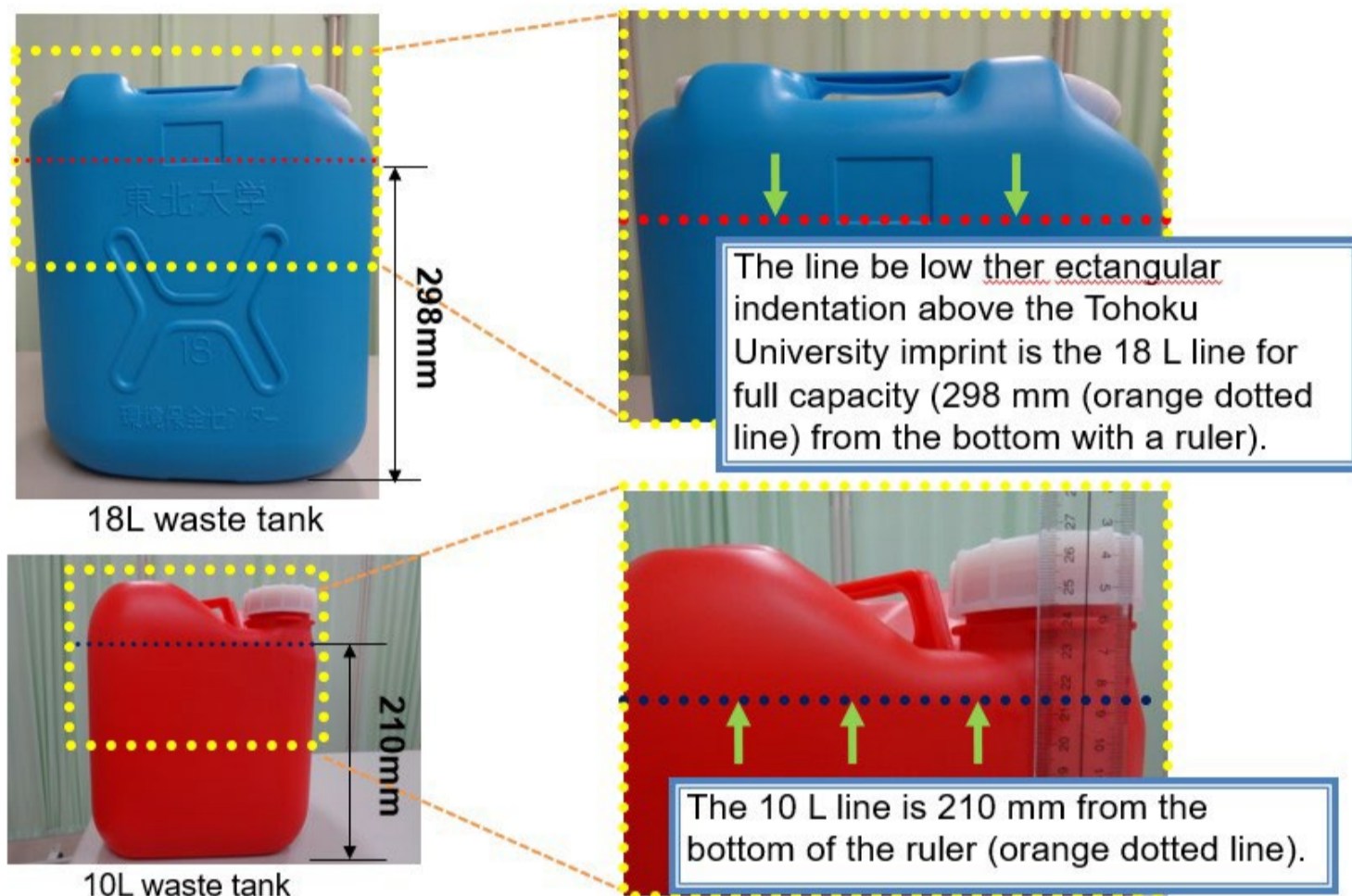


How to check the waste tank fill line

The University's liquid waste tank is 18 L (10 L for A-1) full. Liquid waste tanks exceeding this amount cannot be collected. Also, please note that you will not be able to transfer the liquid waste at the collection site.



Notes and Requests Regarding Tank Numbers

- ① The person in charge of discharge shall check if the liquid waste tank has a liquid waste disposal request form attached.
- ② Check to see if the number on the barcode tag matches the tank number on the liquid waste treatment request form attached to the side of the liquid waste tank.
- ③ If there is a discrepancy as a result of ② above, please contact us as follows

- Examples of contact details: The tank number on the liquid waste treatment request form was "111111111" for "00000000" scheduled for collection on XX.

The above items ① to ③ must be done at least one day in advance. If there is a discrepancy between the barcode tag number and the tank number on the liquid waste disposal request form, If there is a discrepancy between the barcode tag number and the tank number on the liquid waste disposal request form, the liquid waste tank cannot be collected.
